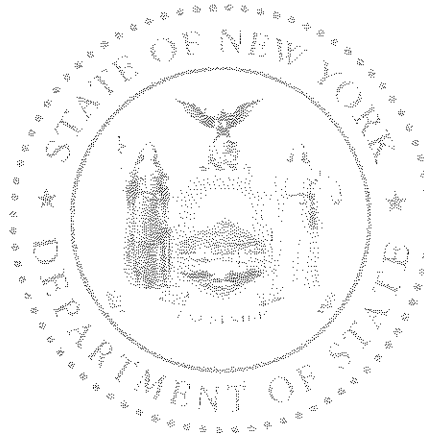

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

FILIPINO AMERICAN LAWYERS ASSOCIATION OF NEW YORK

Under Section 402 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law  
\_\_\_\_\_

The undersigned, a natural person being at least eighteen years of age, for the purpose of forming a not-for-profit corporation under Section 402 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York, does hereby certify:

- FIRST: The name of the corporation is "Filipino American Lawyers Association of New York" ("the Corporation").
- SECOND: The Corporation is a corporation as defined in subparagraph (a)(5) of Section 102 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law.
- THIRD: The purpose for which the Corporation is formed is any purpose for which corporations may be organized under the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law as a non-charitable corporation.
- FOURTH: The Corporation is organized as a bar association to engage in lawful purposes including, but not limited to, the following:
- (a) To develop and represent the interests of the Filipino American community and those of the attorneys from the Filipino American community in the state of New York.
  - (b) To foster the exchange of ideas and information among and between the Corporation's members and other members of the legal profession, the judiciary and the legal community, in general.
  - (c) To encourage and promote the professional growth of the members of the Corporation.
  - (d) To provide an opportunity for fellowship among the Corporation's members.
  - (e) To provide coordinated services to the national and local Filipino American community,
  - (f) To develop and encourage cooperation with other legal and bar associations.

- (g) To provide a vehicle and forum for the unified expression of opinions and positions by the Corporation's members on social, political, economic, legal, and/or other matters or events of concern to the members of the Corporation.

FIFTH: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes specified in Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws. As such, the Corporation is intended to be exempt from federal taxation. The Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(6) of the Code.

SIXTH: No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation in furtherance of one or more of its purposes), and no member, trustee, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the Corporation's assets upon dissolution of the Corporation.

SEVENTH: The Corporation is formed to engage in any activity or for a purpose requiring consent or approval of a state official, department, board, agency or other body. Such consent or approval is attached.

EIGHTH: In the event of the liquidation, dissolution or winding up of the Corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary or by operation of law, all of the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall, after the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation for necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to one or more organizations described in Section 501(c)(6) of the Code.

NINTH: The office of the Corporation is to be located in the County of New York, State of New York.

TENTH: The Corporation shall be operated by a board of directors, the number of which is to be no less than three. The names and addresses of the initial directors of the Corporation are as follows:


